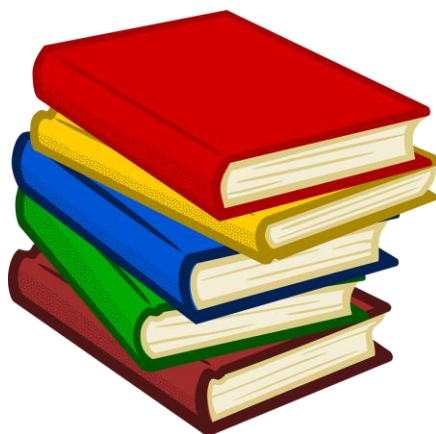




Ardee Library

I should try to be quiet and calm but The Library welcomes everyone and it is ok if I cannot always do so.

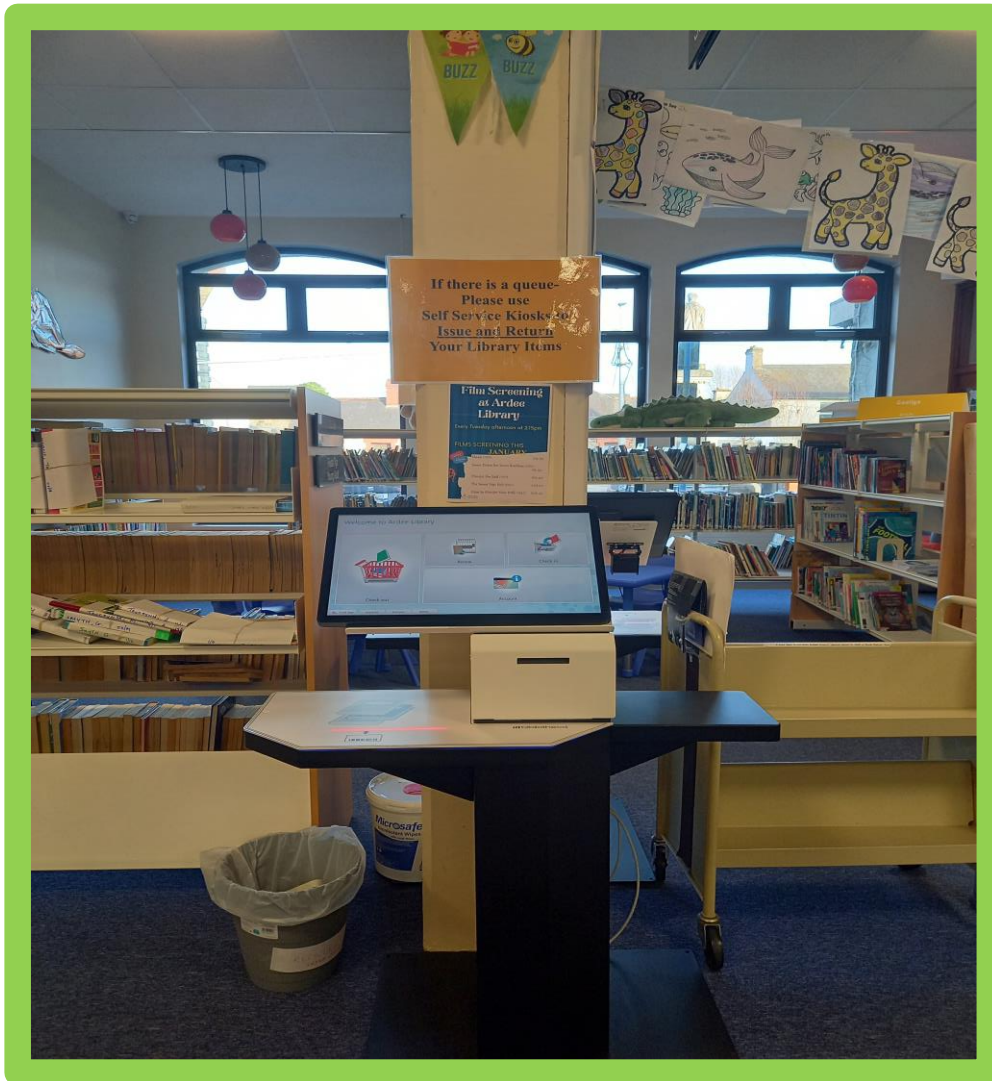
However, there is a quiet time every Saturday Morning from 10 am to 11 am.

If I am at the library at this time then I should try very hard to keep quiet and calm.



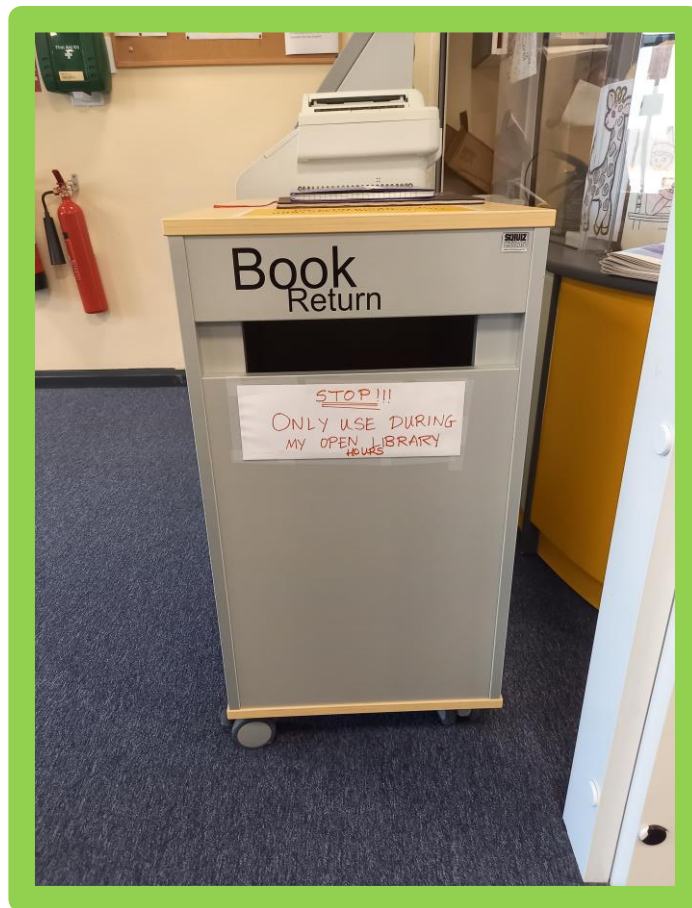
This is the help desk. If I have any questions I can ask a member of staff here.

I can put my returned books in the box beside reception when I am using My Open Library only.

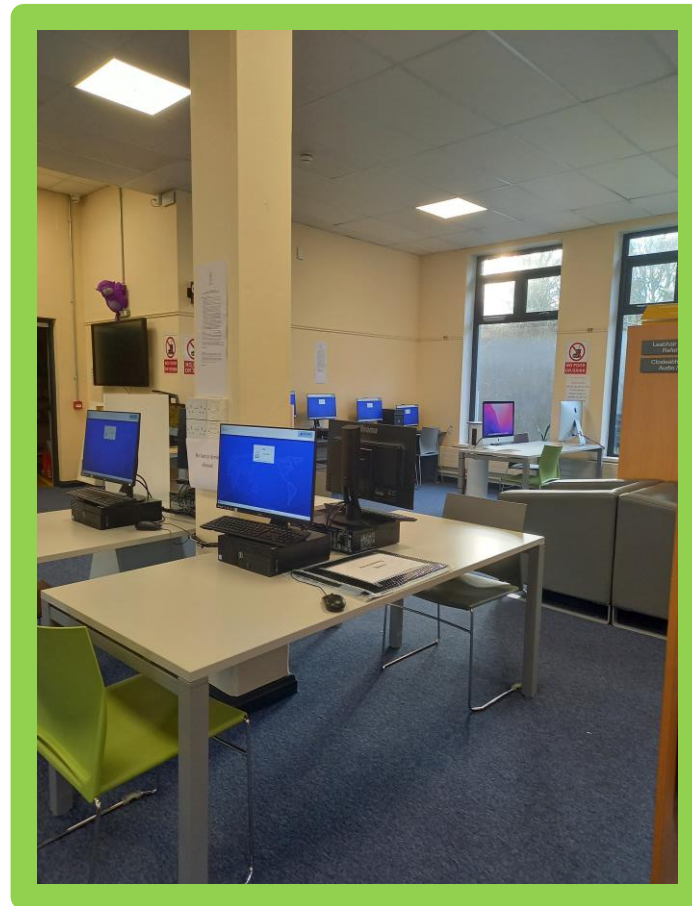
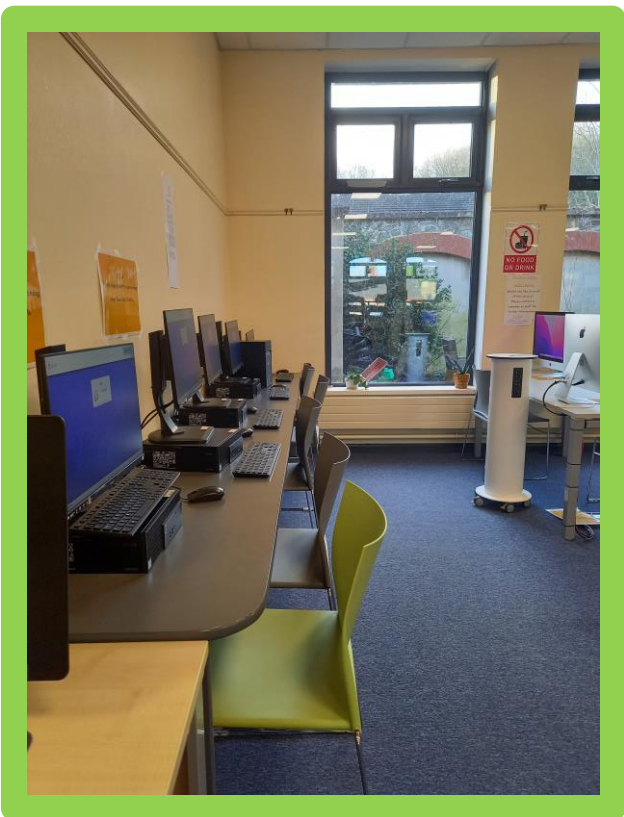


During My Open Library hours, the help desk shutters will be down and I will not be able to speak to a staff member.

This is the children's section. I can sit and read books here. I can also play with the toys that are in the area.



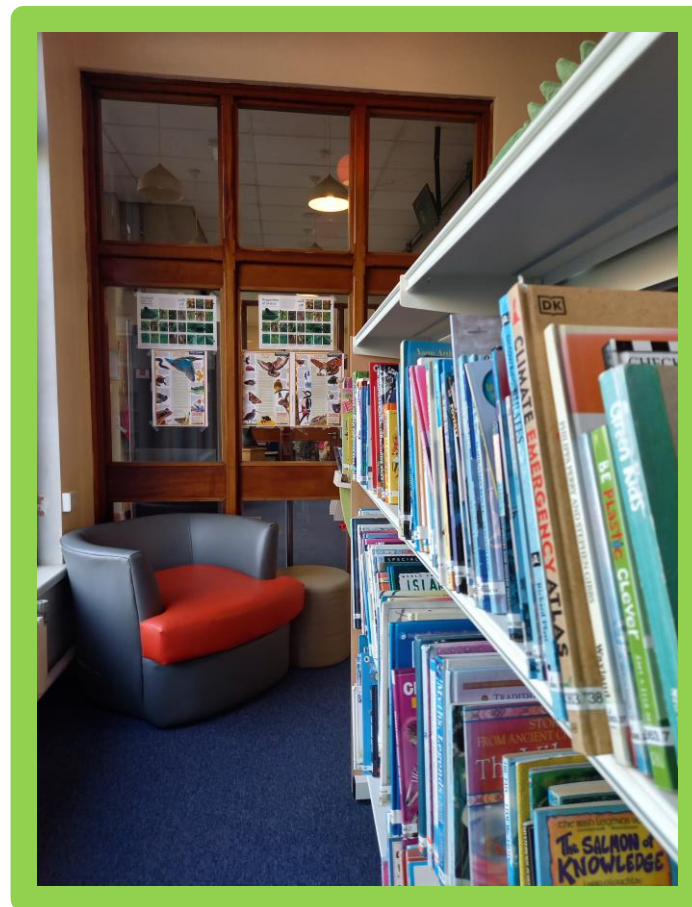
These are the computers.

each section.



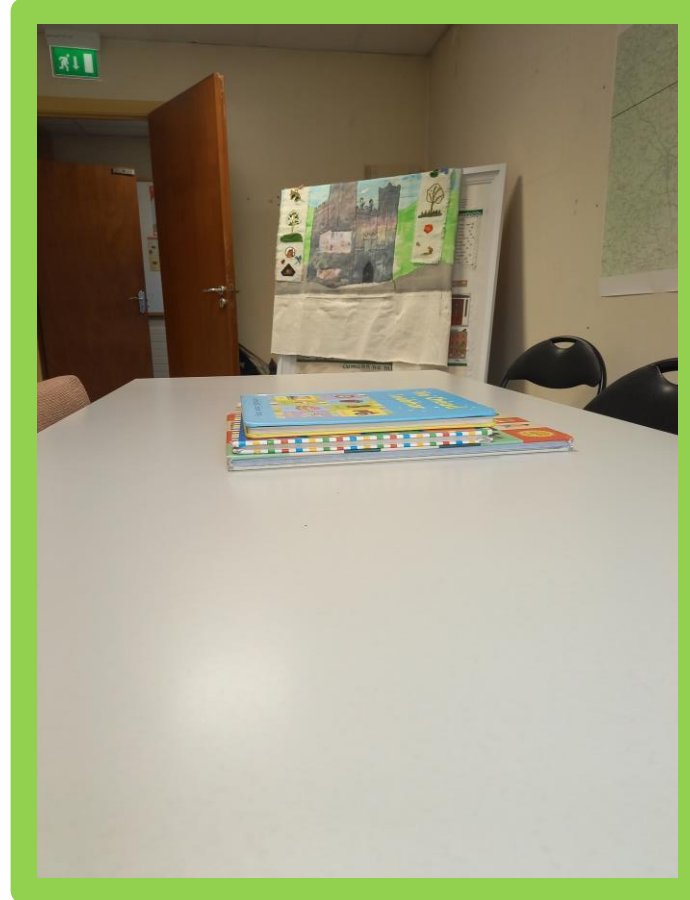
There are lots of seats and tables around that I can use to sit and read my books.
