This is the Castleblayney Road gate to De la Salle College in Dundalk.

Only staff, visitors and parents collecting students can use these gates.

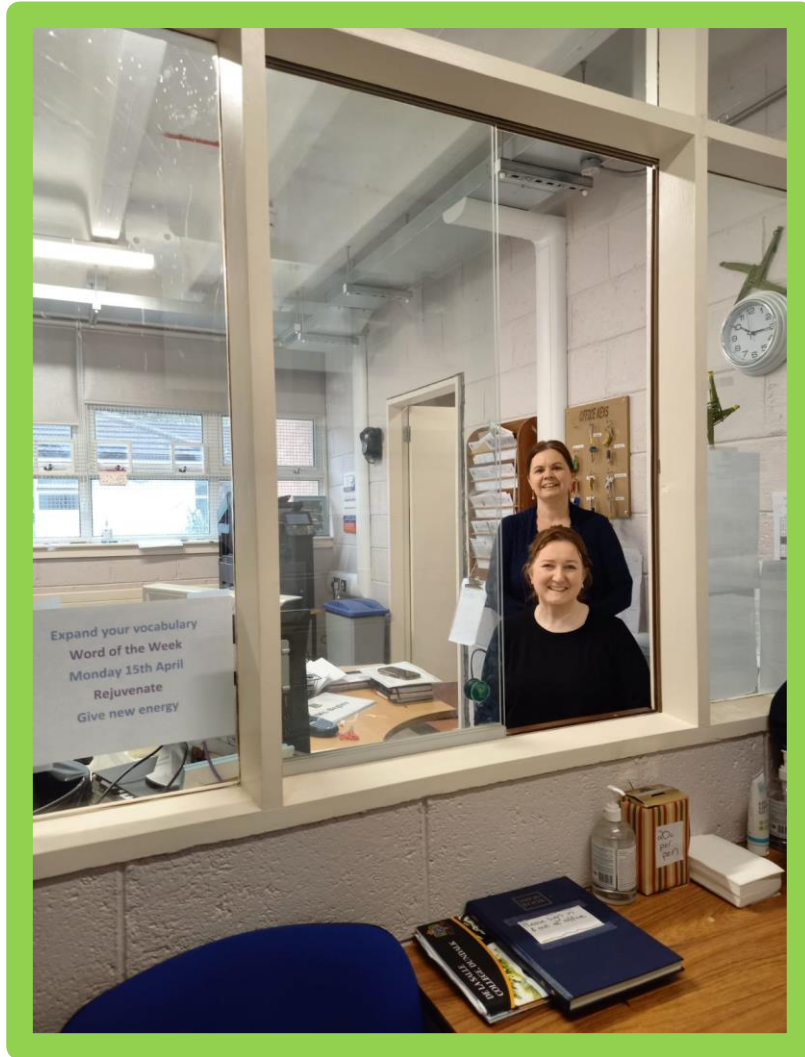
All students must use the Mill Road gate to come and go.

Beyond the gate is a door to the school that parents and visitors can use to get to the reception.



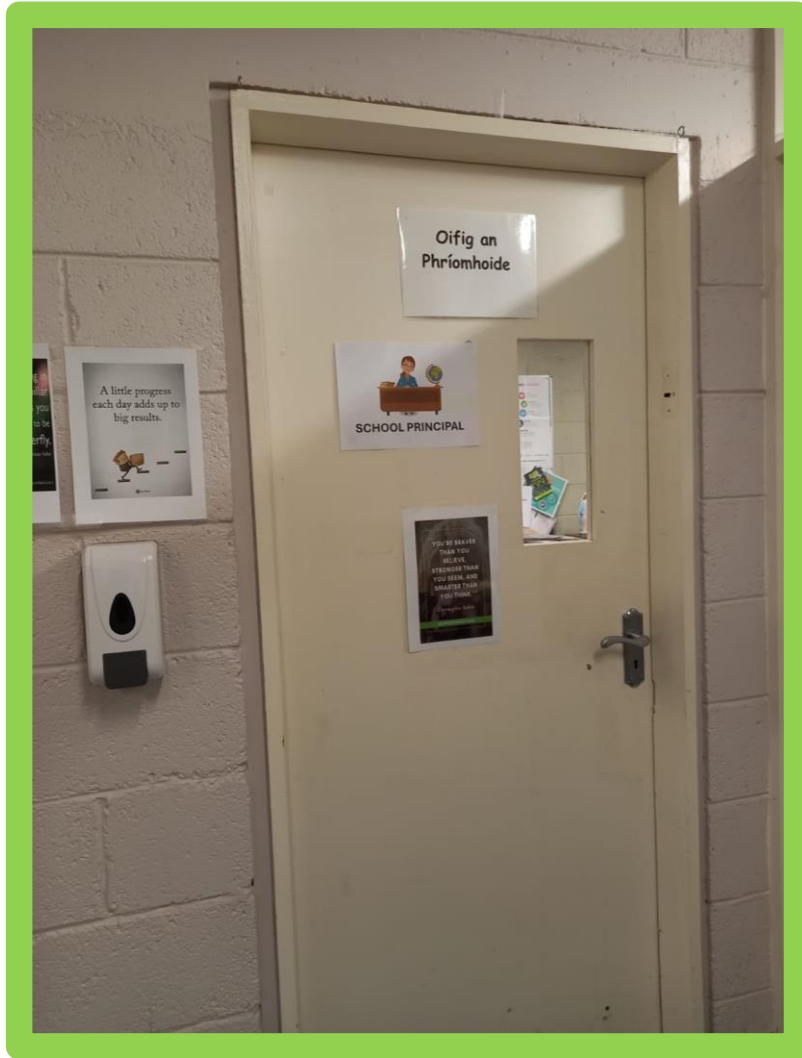
This is the Mill Road gate. Students must use this gate to enter and exit the school each day.

Parents can drop students here. Students are greeted at the gate by the principal and deputy principals.



When I walk through the front door I turn right to get to the reception. This is Joanne and Carmel. They are the receptionists along with Millicent.

I can come here if I'm sick, need to contact home, find teachers, or pay fees. Parents and visitors also come here.



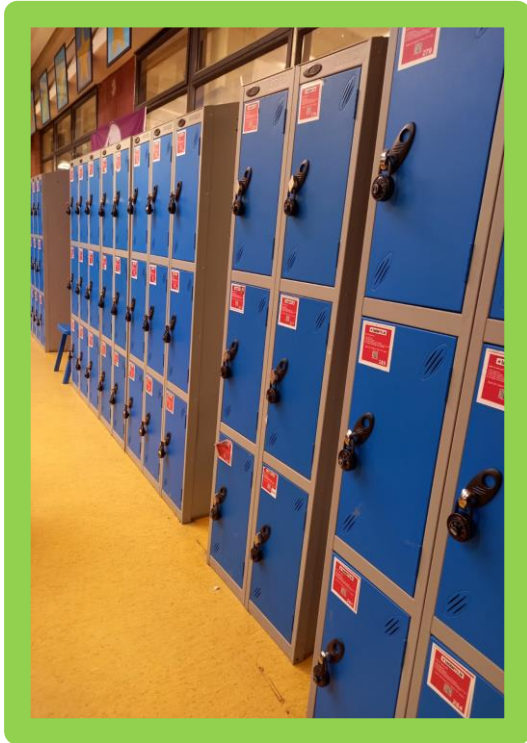
This is the Principal's office. It is next to the reception.

These are the lockers. They are located in La Salle Hall.

On a Friday, Angela the librarian runs a board games day. There is also a book club and jigsaw making.



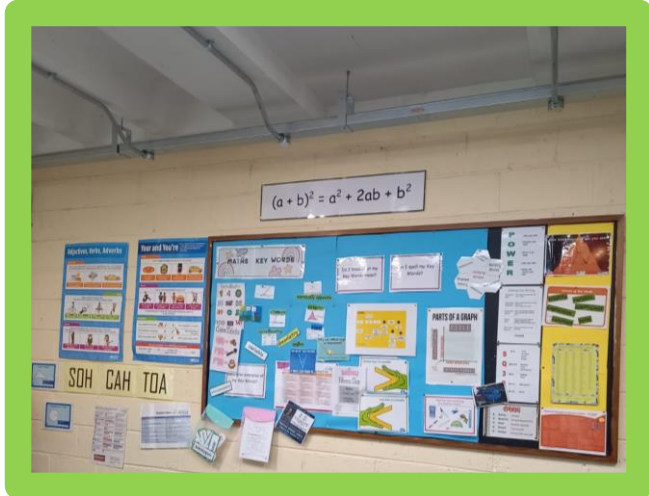
This is the canteen. This is where I go for lunch. I will sit at a table and have my lunch. There is a range of scones, croissants, snacks and hot meals every day.

There is a basketball court and benches that I can sit at.



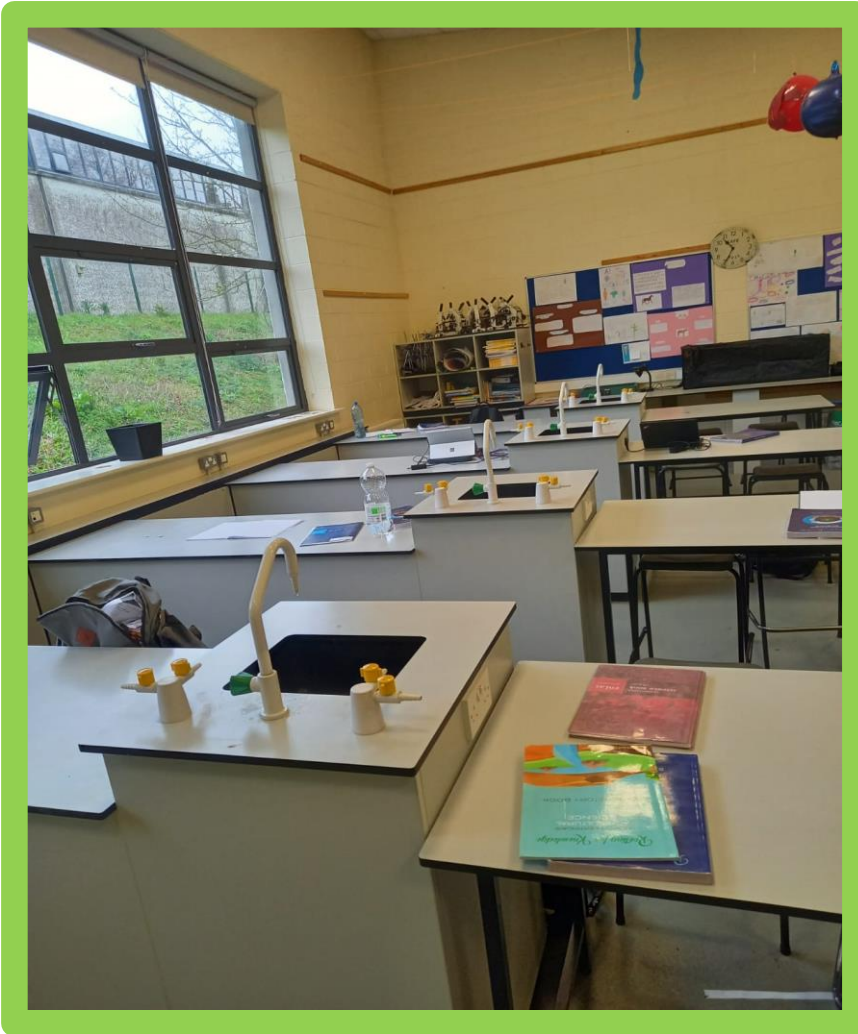
This is the main learning support room.

Music is an optional subject. Every year students perform the Class Act Talent Show in the Town Hall.



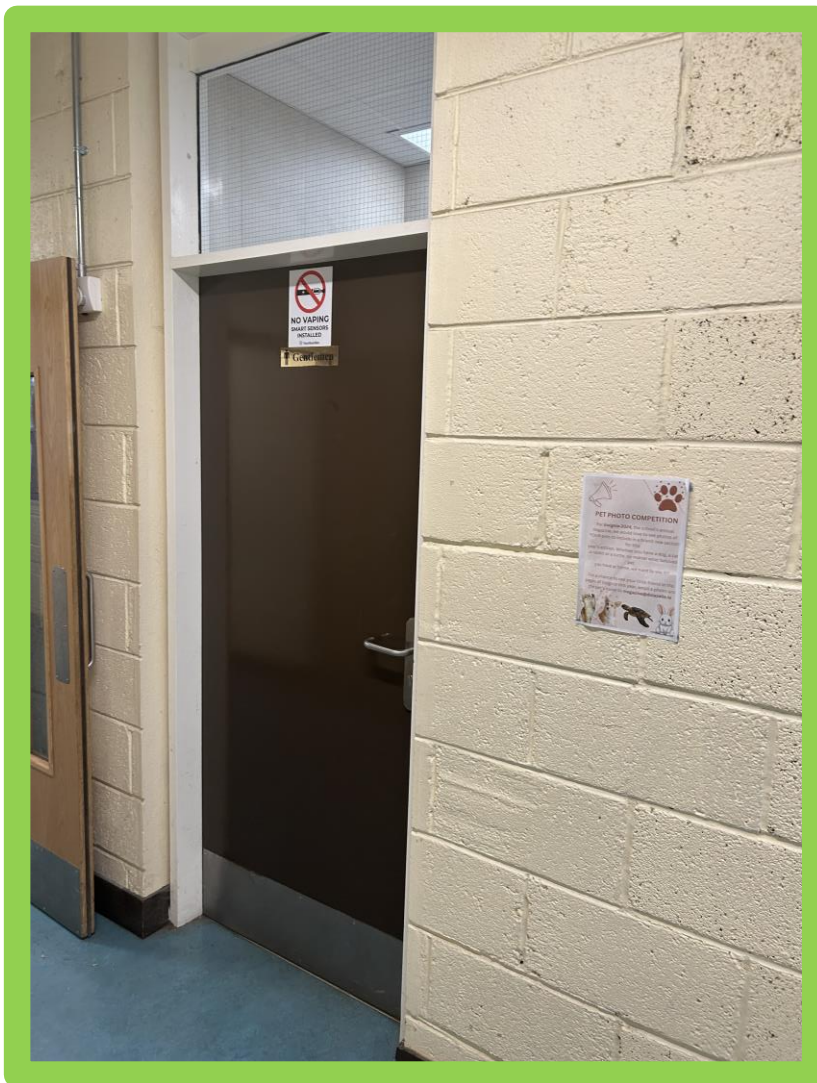
This is the Home Economics room.
