This is the main gate to Drogheda Town Football Club.

This Storyboard will show the steps I need to take to use the all-weather pitch.

Autism Support Louth&Meath can use the all-weather pitch on weekdays from 10 am to 4 pm, except on bank holidays. The club must be contacted first to book the pitch.



This is the car park where my parent/guardian can park while I'm at the club or they can collect me here afterwards.



This is the front door. I can knock on the door to get to the changing rooms.

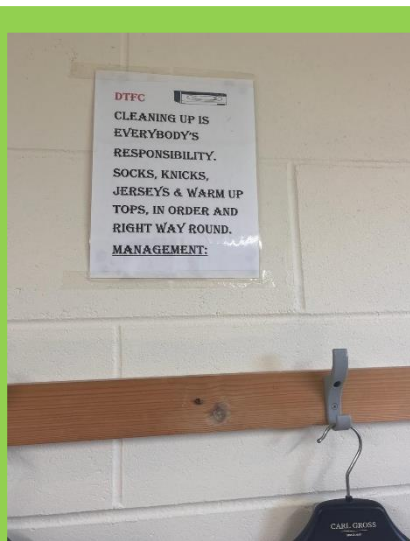


I need to walk straight through the corridor to get to the changing rooms, toilets and the all-weather pitch.



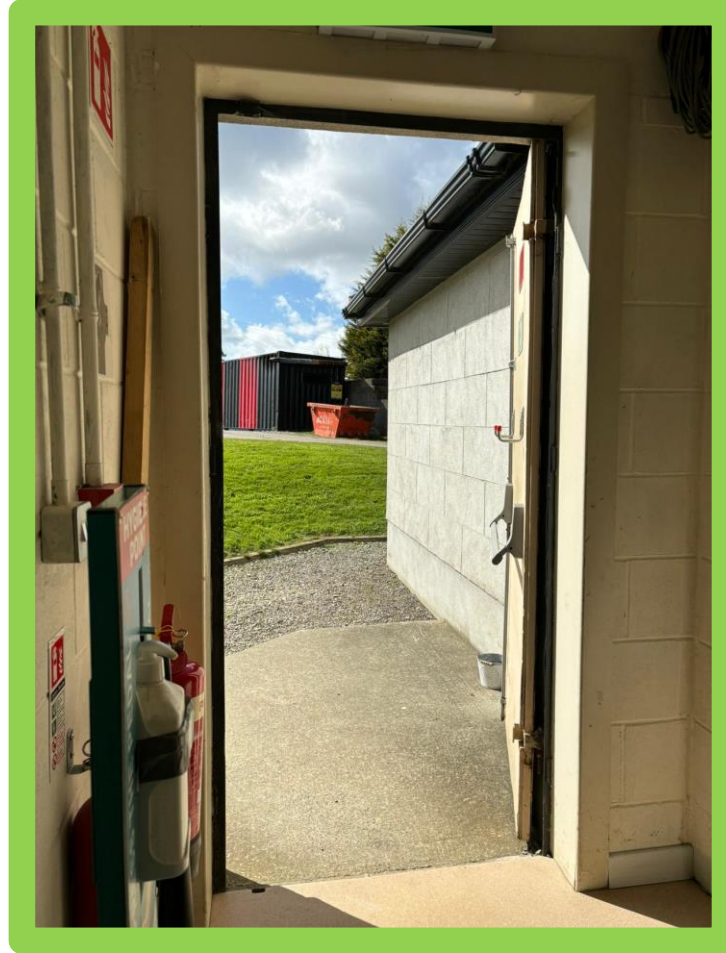
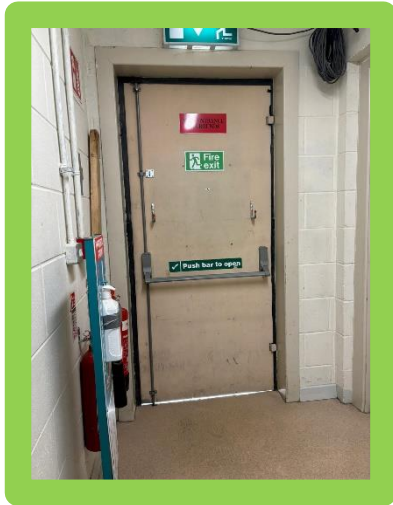
On the left are the changing rooms. There is a changing room for the home and away teams.

I will be told which changing room to use.



Each changing room has changing benches, hangers, a screen and a whiteboard.

I must help to keep the changing room clean and tidy.



To get to the pitch, I walk straight through the corridor to the back door. This will lead out onto the grounds.



Once I am outside I need to walk around the outside of the pitch and follow the gravel path. I need to be careful to stay outside the pitch.

The all-weather pitch has a green net around it and is at the back of the grounds.



The all-weather pitch is surrounded by a green fence. I can get into the pitch through the green gate.



This is the all-weather pitch. I can run around and play here. I should listen to the coaches here. If I need any help I can ask the coaches.



Sometimes when we are playing team games, I might wear a sports vest.

I can wear this on top of my clothes.

I don't have to wear this if I don't want to.



If I need to use the bathrooms they are located in the corridor beside the changing rooms.



At the front door, there is a defibrillator, while the back door has a hand sanitizer. Fire extinguishers are located throughout the building.

Defibrillators and extinguishers should only be used by adults.

If I or anyone else is in pain or there is an emergency, I should always tell an adult.



When I am finished I can leave through the front gates or my parents can collect me from the car park.
